Revising the past

With the first 'PERFORMA' biennial on in New York this month, performance is sure to be the talk of the town. *Godville*, Omer Fast's recent exhibition at iVA, is a video installation constructed from interviews with 18th-century characters: those quaint interpreters in Colonial Williamsburg's living-history museum in Virginia. Scrapbook

Long distances never seem to stop creativity. *Book* is the brainchild of four artists and designers, two in Brooklyn and two in Belfast. Over 36 weeks and a total of 60,000 miles, they sent an artist's sketchbook to one another.
